# **Directions for Use**

Reconditioning of stainless steel surgical instruments: dilute one part **Medi-Sheen** to seven parts hot water, in a stainless steel tray. Open clean instruments and completely immerse in diluted **Medi-Sheen** solution for 12 minutes (severely stained instruments may require up to 30 minutes). Remove & rinse with water. Treat again by scrubbing with **Medi-Sheen**, then rinse thoroughly with water. Severely stained instruments may require second treatment.

Reconditioning of steam sterilizers & autoclaves: dilute one part **Medi-Sheen** to five parts hot water (120°-170°F). Apply to interior surfaces of autoclave. Allow contact for 30 minutes. Brush & rinse. Reconditioning of stainless steel trays & carts: dilute one part **Medi-Sheen** to five parts hot water (120°-170°F). Brush stains & rust away with stiff brush & hot solution. Rinse completely following wash procedure.
